Sharing the Light of the World

(The Pastor, taking a large candle, lights it from the white candle in the middle of the Advent wreath, which symbolizes Christ, the Light of the world of whom John's Gospel speaks. The ushers light their candles from the Pastor's candle, then light the candle of each worshiper nearest the aisle. The lighted candle is never tilted, but is always held upright when giving the light to another.)
